Acts 20: 25-38: The Whole Counsel God.

I. The whole counsel of God: 25-27

Psalm 119:105 - Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

2 Timothy 3:16 - All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness,

<u>1 Peter 2:2</u> - as newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby...

<u>Psalm 33:4</u> - For the word of the LORD is right, and all His work is done in truth.

Psalm 119:140 - Your word is very pure; therefore Your servant loves it.

<u>Psalm 138:2</u> - I will worship toward Your holy temple, and praise Your name, for Your lovingkindness and Your truth; for You have magnified Your word above all Your name.

<u>Proverbs 30:5</u> - Every word of God is pure; He is a shield to those who put their trust in Him.

He has done his job! We also must demand that we are being taught the **whole** counsel of God; not just interesting topics, not just what we want to hear, not just the things that will "grab" people, but what God says to all of our lives.

- II. As A Pastor.
 - i. My call is first, being a shepherd to *feed* you God's Word.
 - ii. Secondly, *watching* over you, protecting you from false teachings and teachers (wolves).
 - iii. It is more blessed to give than to receive.
 - **2 Corinthians 9:7** So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.
 - **2 Corinthians 8:5** And not only as we had hoped, but they first gave themselves to the Lord, and then to us by the will of God.

Am here to give myself to you; this is the best beatitude of all. In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus told us how to be blessed; here, He tells us how to be **more** blessed!
