I. Visitation

<u>Luke 1:26</u> - Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth,

II. Conception and Incarnation

<u>Luke 1:35</u> - And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.

<u>John 1:14</u> - "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth."

III. Declaration
