## The Cross: Seven Sayings.

i. "Father, forgive them..."

<u>Luke 23:34</u> - Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." And they divided His garments and cast lots.

Jesus forgave and forgives because we "do not know what we are doing..."

II. "Today...with me in paradise"

<u>Luke 23:43</u> - And Jesus said to him, "Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise."

Adam and Eve were dismissed and not allowed to return to Eden; Christ offers us Paradise forever the moment we repent.

III. "Woman, behold your son..."

<u>John 19:27</u> - Then He said to the disciple, "Behold your mother!" And from that hour that disciple took her to his own home.

Jesus gives us responsibility to watch over one another...widows, orphans, needy...

IV. "My God, My God..."

<u>Matthew 27:46</u> - And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?

For our sins He was forsaken...no one wants to be forsaken even when deserving.

v. "I thirst"

<u>John 19:28</u> - After this, Jesus, knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, said, "I thirst!"

Jesus suffocated to death that He would pour upon us His Living Water.

vi. "It is finished"

<u>John 19:30</u> - So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

Jesus effected salvation completely; everything that was done was done and completely done.

vii. "Into your hands..."

<u>Luke 23:46</u> - And when Jesus had cried out with a loud voice, He said, "Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit.'" Having said this, He breathed His last. The relationship between the Father and Son is so perfect that nothing can come in between – Jesus came doing the Father's will, He was obedient to the Father while doing Hi will and eventually in the Father's hands He was after accomplishing the mission.
